INSURANCE COVERAGE

If you find the insurance process confusing, you're not alone. KaryForward will support you in navigating this complex system by helping you to:

- Access treatment with Karyopharm medications even if there are unexpected delays or interruptions (using the Quick Start Program or in the case of interruptions, the Bridge Fill Program)



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

We understand that prescriptions can sometimes be costly. KaryForward can help you with the cost of Karyopharm medications.

If eligible, you may be able to:

- Qualify for the [Copay Program](#) and pay as little as \$5 for each prescription

OR

- Qualify to receive Karyopharm medications at no cost to you

If you don't meet the eligibility criteria, KaryForward may be able to help find you alternative sources of coverage.

SUPPORT AND RESOURCES

The Nurse Case Manager is your single point of contact and will help you and your caregivers find the resources that are most important, so you can stay focused on treatment.

The Nurse Case Managers are there to support, not replace, your treatment plan and do not provide medical advice. They're available to:

- Explain prescription instructions
- Provide psychosocial support and additional non-clinical education regarding Karyopharm medications
- Highlight what to expect when taking Karyopharm medications and the importance of speaking with healthcare providers about your treatment journey
- Refer additional third-party support, such as transportation assistance
